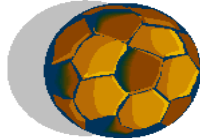

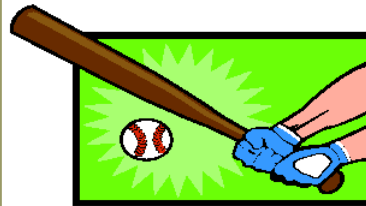

Vinyasa Yoga

Vinyasa is a term covering a broad range of yoga classes. The word Vinyasa means “breath-synchronized movement.” In other words, the teacher will instruct you to move from one pose to the next on an inhale or an exhale. This technique is sometimes also called Vinyasa Flow, or just Flow, because of the smooth way the poses run together and become like a dance. This style allows for a lot of variety. Expect movement not just stretching. This class is appropriate for all fitness levels. Wear comfortable clothing, bring a blanket or sweater for cool down portion of workout and don’t forget to bring a yoga/Pilates mat to class.
