

**RESOLUTION  
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
THE CENTRAL TEXAS COLLEGE DISTRICT  
COMPLIANCE WITH THE AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT TITLE II**

WHEREAS, the American with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) makes it unlawful to exclude a student or prospective student with a disability from participation in or be denied the benefits of the programs, services, or activities of Central Texas College, by reason of such disability; and

WHEREAS, the ADA makes it unlawful for Central Texas College to exclude or otherwise deny equal services, programs, or activities to a student or prospective student because of the known disability of that student or prospective student with whom that individual is known to have a relationship or association; and

WHEREAS, the ADA states that a qualified individual with a disability is an individual with a disability who, with or without reasonable modifications to rules, policies, or practices, the removal or architectural, communication, or transportation barriers, or the provision of auxiliary aids and services meets the essential eligibility requirements for the receipt of services or the participation in programs or activities provided by Central Texas College; and

WHEREAS, the ADA requires that Central Texas College shall make reasonable modifications in policies, practices, or procedures when the modifications are necessary to avoid discrimination on the basis of disability, unless the modifications would fundamentally alter the nature of the service, program, or activity; and

WHEREAS, the ADA requires that Central Texas College designate all least one employee to coordinate its efforts to comply with and carry out its responsibilities under Title II of the ADA, including any investigation of any complaint communicated to it alleging the non-compliance or alleging any actions that would be prohibited under the ADA.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a committee consisting of the below listed employees is hereby appointed as the Central Texas College ADA Title II Committee and this Committee is authorized to coordinate the implementation of all provisions of the Act relative to access to programs, services, and activities:


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Central Texas College ADA Title II Committee shall be authorized to investigate any complaint communicated to it alleging non-compliance or alleging any actions that would be prohibited under the ADA. The Committee shall adopt and publish procedures for the prompt and equitable resolution of complaints.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Central Texas College ADA Title II Committee shall be responsible for providing to all applicants, students, faculty, and staff, and other interested persons, information regarding the provisions of Title II of the ADA and its applicability to Central Texas College. In addition, the Committee shall make available to all interested individuals, the name, office address, and telephone number of all designated Committee members


