

Did you know that you could graduate with additional AAS Degrees and Certificates?

Many of our classes are transferable across our program therefore students are encouraged to take additional classes in order to graduate with multiple degrees and certificates.

Students on the 2014 Social Work Specialization AAS Degree, can also get;

- At-Risk Youth Specialization AAS Degree by taking only 2 additional classes: DAAC 2307 and PSYT 2345.
- At-Risk Youth Advanced Certificate by taking only 3 additional classes: DAAC 2306, DAAC 2307, and PSYT 2345.
- Chemical Dependency Counseling AAS Degree and/or Certificate by taking only 4 additional classes: DAAC 1309, DAAC 2307, PSYT 2345, and DAAC 2341, but students will also have to do the 300 hour DAAC 2367 practicum instead of the 120 hour CMSW 1167 practicum.
- Criminal Justice Addictions Certificate by taking only 5 additional classes: DAAC 1309, DAAC 2307, PSYT 2345, DAAC 2301, and DAAC 2341, but students will also have to do the 300 hour DAAC 2367 practicum instead of the 120 hour CMSW 1167 practicum.

Note: Students who complete the Social Work Specialization AAS Degree will automatically meet the requirements to obtain the **Basic Mental Health Professional Certificate**, but will need to complete a separate graduation application form in order to receive it.

Students on the 2014 At-Risk Youth Specialization AAS Degree, can also get;

- Social Work AAS Degree by taking only 2 additional classes: SOCW 2361 and SOCW 2362.
- Chemical Dependency Counseling AAS Degree and/or Certificate by taking only 2 additional classes: DAAC 1309
 and DAAC 2341, but students will also have to do the 300 hour DAAC 2367 practicum instead of the 120 hour CMSW 1167
 practicum.
- Criminal Justice Addictions Certificate by taking only 3 additional classes (DAAC 1309, DAAC 2301, and DAAC 2341), but students will also have to do the 300 hour DAAC 2367 practicum instead of the 120 hour CMSW 1167 practicum.

Note: Students who complete the At-Risk Youth Specialization AAS Degree will automatically meet the requirements to obtain the **Basic Mental Health Professional Certificate**, but will need to complete a separate graduation application form in order to receive it.

Students on the 2014 Chemical Dependency Specialization AAS Degree, can also get;

- Criminal Justice Addictions Certificate by taking only 1 additional class: DAAC 2301.
- Substance Abuse Prevention Specialist Certificate by taking only 2 additional classes: DAAC 2306 and DAAC 2353, as
 well as substituting DAAC 1167 with the DAAC 2367 practicum.
- At-Risk Youth Specialization AAS Degree by taking only 2 additional classes: GOVT 2305 and SCWK 2301, and substituting CMSW 1167 with the DAAC 2367 practicum.
- At-Risk Youth Advanced Certificate by taking only 2 additional classes: DAAC 2306 and SCWK 2301, and substituting CMSW 1167 with the DAAC 2367 practicum.
- Social Work AAS Degree by taking only 4 additional classes: GOVT 2305, SOCW 2361, SOCW 2362 and SCWK 2301, and substituting CMSW 1167 with the DAAC 2367 practicum.

Note: Students who complete the Chemical Dependency Specialization AAS Degree will automatically meet the requirements to obtain the **Chemical Dependency Counseling Certificate** and **Basic Mental Health Professional Certificate**, but will need to complete separate graduation application forms in order to receive them.
