Degree Objective/Requirements: Prepares graduates for transfer to bachelor degree programs of study by introducing a broad base of concepts in the humanities, social/behavioral sciences, mathematics, and natural and physical sciences. Graduates receiving the associate of arts degree will be prepared for further study at the university level in the performing arts, service professions, and related fields. The degree plan comprises 66 semester credit hours of which 56 are in general education courses and 10 are in a university parallel specialization. Students are encouraged to complete the 10 semester hours specialization in a major field of study.
