Degree Objective: Provides students with a foundation in general education courses that are appropriate for transfer to a four-year degree program and allows students to structure a program based on their interests and educational goals.

Degree Requirements: 64 semester hours of which 29 semester hours are in English, communications, U.S. government, U.S. History, humanities/fine arts, mathematics, computer skills/technology, and physical education. The remaining 35 semester hours may be in an area of interest to the student. Credits earned through CCAF may be used toward the free electives and some CCAF credits apply toward the general education requirements.
