Child Development Associate (CDA) Training III

The Council for Early Childhood Professional Recognition operates the CDA credentialing program as a major national effort to improve the quality of child care. Focusing on childcare provider skills, the program is designed to provide performance-based training plus assessment and credentialing of child care staff, family child care providers and home visitors. Training I, II and III may be taken in any order. Any of these classes can be used to complete the Resource File Requirement. In Training III, students will apply their knowledge of the young child's creative, cognitive, physical and language development. Students will also utilize skills in writing, speaking, teamwork, time management and problem solving. Plan to spend approximately \$67.75 on a textbook. For more information, contact 526-1900.
