Clinical Medical Assistant NEW!

According to the US Department of Labor employment of medical assistants is expected to increase 35% through the year 2016. Clinical Medical Assistants work in a physician's office or a clinic setting helping physicians carry out procedures, care for patients, perform basic lab tests and administer medications. Learning objectives include but are not limited to identification of body parts and their functions, medical terminology, specimen collection, administration of oral and injectable medications and patient communication. Students must be 18 years of age, possess a high school diploma or equivalent and are required to pass an English and Math assessment test on the first day of class. Class includes a three-week externship.
