

Orthopedic Technician NEW!

Learn the skills necessary to care for orthopedic patients in an acute or clinic setting. The course combines theory and practical instruction allowing participants to become proficient in identification of the anatomical components of the musculoskeletal system, description of the function of the musculoskeletal system, application of splints, casts and braces, documentation of care given and the preparation of patients for procedures and the aftercare required. Competency will be measured by return demonstrations and practical examinations. Students are required to take an English and Math assessment the first day of class. Financing is available. Upon the successful completion of this 182-hour course, a 160-hour externship and after 12 months of experience, each graduate will have satisfied all the training requirements meeting the recommendations of the National Association of Orthopedic Technologists (NAOT) and will become eligible to take the optional NAOT certification examination.
