Register for on-site classes for the next term – **March 30 – May 24** – will end on **March 20**. Some exciting new course offerings at Bolling:

BUSI 1307 – *Personal Finance* – (3 credit hours): “Personal and family

accounts, budgets, and budgetary controls, bank accounts, charge accounts, borrowing, investing, insurance, standards of living, renting, home ownership, wills and trust plans.” (MW; 5:15-7:45)

- **SPAN 2311** – *Intermediate Spanish I* (3 credit hours): The study of grammar and vocabulary with emphasis on conversation and writing. This course will introduce students to Spanish culture and history as well as Latin American culture and history. (Sat; 9:00 – 3:00 p.m.) **Prerequisite:** Two years of high school Spanish or successfully passing the placement test.

At Bethesda:

- **SOCI 2319** – *Minority Studies I* – (3 credit hours): The historical, economic, social, and cultural development of minority groups. May include African-American, Mexican-American, Asian-American, and Native-American issues. (TTH; 5:00 – 7:45).

- **MATH 2412** – *Precalculus Math* (4 credit hours): “Topics include applications of algebra and trigonometry to the study of elementary functions and their graphs including polynomial, rational, exponential, logarithmic, and trigonometric functions. **Prerequisite:** **MATH 1414 with a grade of “C” or above.** (A previous study of trigonometry is helpful but not required.)
