**Tuition Information**

**Tuition:** \$150 per semester hour    **Total cost:** 3 credit hours - \$450, 4 credit hours - \$600    **Checks and Money Orders are accepted. \*NO CASH\***

**Withdrawal/Refunds**

All students who sign a registration form must sign a drop form. Refunds are calculated based from the date the application for Withdrawal/Refund is filed, according to the following schedule:

- **100 %** of tuition refunded if class is dropped **BEFORE the first week of class (not during the first week).**
- **75 %** of tuition is refunded if drop is effective **BEFORE the second week of class (not during the second week).**
- **25%** of tuition refunded if drop is effective **BEFORE the third week of class (not during the third week).**
- **No Refunds on or after the third week of class.**

**\* This refund schedule does not apply to GoArmyEd/eArmyU students.\***

**Financial Assistance**

- **Tuition Assistance:** Active Duty military students approved under this program will have 100% of the tuition and fees paid by the government. Book fees are paid by students.
- **Active Duty, VA/VEAP:** Students must pay 100% of the tuition when enrolling.
- **Civilian & Veterans CH 30 Montgomery GI Bill/VEAP:** Students must pay 100% of the tuition when enrolling.
- **Pell Grant:** Students whose grants are pre-approved will be required to pay 100% of the portion of tuition that is not covered by the grant.
- **Guaranteed Student Loan:** Students must pay 100% when enrolling in class.

**Official Evaluations**

Upon completion of 6 semester hours with grades of “C” or higher, and receipt of AARTS, official transcripts, etc., Central Texas College will evaluate military experience and schools for course credit. For more details, please contact our office.
