

Associate in General Studies (AGS)

The two-year General Studies program offers a wide selection of courses to fulfill degree requirements for students who have special education needs that are:

- not satisfied by other degree programs
- who want to experiment in diverse areas
- who want to expand their base of knowledge or enhance their personal development
- who are looking for particular skills
- who are employed and feel a need to expand overall skills to better meet new employment needs.



The program allows each student the flexibility of choosing to complete a degree without an area of emphasis. Students are assisted by counselors in designing a program of unique study to meet their needs. One may obtain elective credit for military and/or civilian work experience. In addition, college credit may be granted through the evaluation of the College Level Entrance Program (CLEP) scores and college entrance scores (ACT/SAT). The General Studies program affords a student the opportunity to obtain the associate degree in a more rapid manner than specific degree plans allow.
