- DEVELOPMENTAL CLASSES:** Developmental Math (DSMA) and English (DSWR) classes are prerequisites for the ENGL 1301 & MATH 1414 and count as RESIDENCY CREDIT but cannot be applied towards degree requirements.
- TUITION INFORMATION:** Tuition for all courses is **\$150.00** per credit hour. There is a \$24.00 lab fee for Science courses. All payments are due at the time of registration. Official registration is complete only after tuition payment has been paid in full. Tuition does not include books.  
 \*\*Fees are subject to change as approved by the Board of Trustees\*\*
- PAYMENTS:** Payment of tuition and fees may be made by check, money order or credit card.  
**ABSOLUTELY NO CASH PAYMENTS ACCEPTED.**  
 A **\$25.00** NSF fee will be charged for checks returned marked INSUFFICIENT FUNDS OR ACCOUNT CLOSED.
- WITHDRAWAL/REFUNDS:** **THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF WITHDRAWAL IS THE DATE THE FORM IS SIGNED.** Refunds will be computed from the effective date and will be made according to the following schedule:
- 100% refund: Withdrawal **BEFORE** the first day of the term semester.
  - 75% refund: Withdrawal if not more than 1/8 of the term or semester has elapsed.
  - 25% refund: Withdrawal if not more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed.
  - 0% refund: Withdrawal if more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed.

### Financial Assistance

- **Tuition Assistance:** 100% of the tuition and fees are paid by the government.
- **Active Duty, VA/VEAP:** Students must pay 100% of the tuition & fees.
- **Civilian & Veterans CH 30 Montgomery GI Bill/VEAP:** Students must pay 100% of the tuition & fees.
- **Pell Grant:** Students must pay the portion of tuition that is not covered by the grant.
- **Guaranteed Student Loan:** Students must pay 100% tuition & fees.

### Official Evaluations

Upon completion of 6 semester hours with grades of "C" or higher, and receipt of AARTS, official transcripts, etc., Central Texas College will evaluate transcripts and military experience/schools for course credit. For more details, please contact our office.
