NO CASH

Students are responsible for any additional amounts due CTC for post-enrollment audits and corrections, including all fees and waivers: i.e., registration assessing errors, dropping or adding classes, invalid employment or third-party waivers, etc.

Withdrawal/Refunds

All students who sign a registration form must sign a drop form. All refunds will be computed from the date the application for Withdrawal/Refund is filed, according to the following schedule:

- **100%** Withdrawal before the first day of the term or semester.
- **75%** Withdrawal if not more than 1/8 of the term or semester has elapsed.
- **25%** is not more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed.
- **0%** Withdrawal if more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed.

*** Refund schedule is calculated based on the first calendar day of the term and includes all weekdays, Monday through Friday, which are not designated official Central Texas College holidays.**

Financial Assistance

- **Tuition Assistance:** Active Duty military student approved under this program will have 100% of the tuition and fees paid by the government. Book fees are paid by students.
- **Active Duty, VA/VEAP:** Students must pay 100% of the tuition when enrolling.
- **MyCAA:** Students must turn in Financial Assistance Voucher at the time of registration.
- **Civilian & Veterans CH 30 Montgomery GI Bill/VEAP:** Students must pay 100% of the tuition when enrolling.
- **Pell Grant:** Student s whose grants are pre-approved will be required to pay 100% of the portion of tuition that is not covered by the grant.
- **Guaranteed Student Loan:** Students must pay 100% when enrolling in class.
