

## TSI Course List for CTC Degree Seeking Transfer Students

Transfer students from regionally accredited out-of-state or private institutions of higher education who are seeking a degree or certificate (over 42 semester hours) from CTC may have met TSI requirements through other coursework. Two options are available:

1. Student must have completed (C or better) a college-level course that meets the state of Texas CTC Core Curriculum requirements in Communications—English only, mathematics, or reading (Social/Behavioral Sciences and ENGL literature courses) for the appropriate skill level.
2. Student has satisfactorily completed (C or better) 15 semester hours in courses equivalent to the CTC Core Curriculum courses with the exception of physical education and computer technology courses; is in good academic standing; and has no grades lower than a C.

Although a list is provided below of the C or better courses, please refer to the Core Curriculum in the online TX Campus College Catalog for the latest information. In rare situations a student may have completed a course that does not articulate to a core curriculum course that may be used. In such situations, course exceptions can only be approved by the Dean, Student Developmental Services, or Director of Admissions/Recruitment.
