Special Note: For Dual Credit Only, when the TAKS 10th grade exam is used for TSI purposes (based on the THECB rules), a score of 2300 will place students in MATH 1414. However, students are encouraged to take an approved TSI assessment for placement purposes. The student's ASSET/ACCUPLACER/COMPASS/THEA score regardless of test date or score supersedes the TAKS 10th grade score for placement purposes.
