ROADMAP TO SUCCESS Texas Success Initiative Individualized Education Plan

The Texas Success Initiative is a program of assessment, advising, and remediation to ensure that students have the skills to be successful in freshman academic coursework. TSI requires that students be assessed in reading, writing, and math skills prior to enrolling in college unless the student is TSI-exempt or TSI-waived. To meet TSI standards, students must achieve the minimum passing scores on one of the approved TSI tests as listed in the Central Texas College (CTC) Course Catalog. The TSI is applicable to students attending CTC Texas locations and distant learners who are *bona fide* Texas residents paying in-state tuition rates regardless of location. All new and former students must meet with an academic advisor prior to registering for classes to determine their TSI status and educational plan. This TSI form is used on the CTC Central Campus, Fort Hood Campus, and in the District Service Area. The purpose of the "Roadmap to Success" is to provide academic guidance to help students meet their educational objectives at CTC and to comply with Texas Success Initiative regulations.

Students should refer to the current Course Catalog for individual major and program required scores and consult with an academic advisor regarding questions about major or program requirements.
- Any student may retest subject to test availability and guidelines in an effort to meet the state's minimum passing standards.
- All students must complete CTC's test and course prerequisites as indicated in the Course Catalog.
