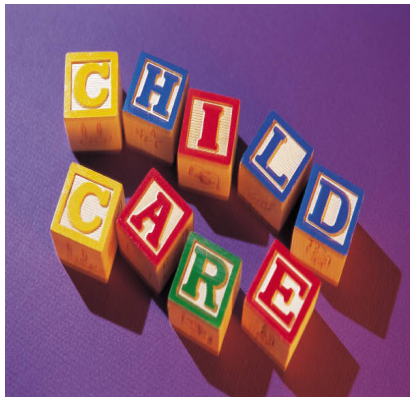
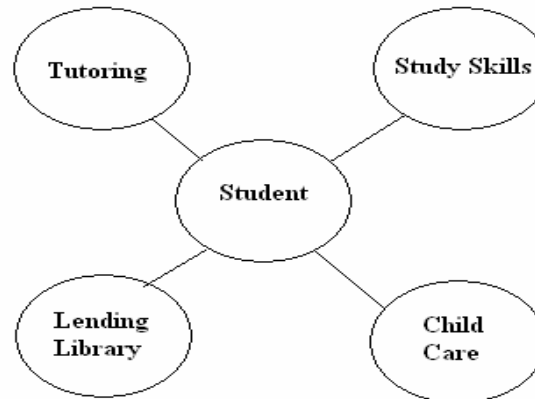

Who is Eligible for Child Care?

Students majoring in vocational, technical, and certificate programs are eligible for child care services.

Students must:

- Have a vocational/technical degree plan or a non-traditional major.
- Apply and complete the process for financial aid (Pell Grant)
- Meet income guidelines



* Students are eligible for up to three years unless they have been admitted to, and are on the wait list for the Nursing Program.

How Do I Apply For Child Care?

Visit our office in the Student Center Building 106, Room 106. Application packets are issued only during specified dates (check with program for dates).

Students must:

- Complete a child care application
- Fill out an intake questionnaire
- Fill out the income verification form

What Documents Do I Need?

Once the student has met the program qualifications, the student must:

- Provide a copy of the birth certificate for each child in the program
- Provide a copy of the degree plan and class schedule, as well as a time table for expected graduation.

*The selection process for CTC Child Care services is based on greatest economic need.

What Child Care Centers Are Available?

Students may choose any licensed day care facility or any certified homecare provider. CTC Child Care Services does not refer any student to the child care centers.



*Students receiving child care assistance from another entity are not eligible to receive financial assistance from CTC Child Care services.
