Mr. Jim Yeonopolus was unanimously approved to serve as Chancellor for Central Texas College during the December,

2015 meeting of the Board of Trustees. It was stated that Mr. Yeonopolus has been a part of CTC for a very long time and that he knows every aspect of the college.

Mr. Yeonopolus is a military veteran and served as a member of Advisory Team 162, Vietnamese Airborne Division from 1970 - 1971. He served as president of the Vietnamese Airborne Division Association in 2003 - 04 and was recognized for his military accom-

plishments by being named the 2008 Airborne Man of the Year.

Following military service, Mr. Yeonopolus began his CTC career in 1973. He first served as a counselor for student services and has since held numerous jobs including deputy chancellor, assistant deputy chancellor and dean.

Mr. Yeonopolus served on the Military Affairs Committee for the Greater Killeen Chamber of Commerce, the local United Way board of directors, the Killeen Volunteers Inc. board of directors, president of the Council of College and Military Educators and past president and current member of other service organizations.
