All refunds will be computed from the date the application for Withdrawal/Refund is filed, according to the following schedule:</p> <p><i>100% Withdrawal before the first day of the term or semester.</i> <i>75% Withdrawal if not more than 1/8 of the term or semester has elapsed.</i> <i>25% Withdrawal if not more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed.</i> <i>0% Withdrawal if more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed.</i></p> <p>*Refund schedule is calculated based on the first calendar day of the term and includes all weekdays, Monday through Friday, which are not designated official Central Texas College holidays.</p>
