TUITION - \$110 per Semester Hour TOTAL COST OF 3CR COURSE: \$330 TOTAL COST OF 4CR COURSE: \$440	All students who sign a registration form must sign a drop form. All refunds will be computed from the date the application for Withdrawal/Refund is filed, according to the following schedule: <i>100% Withdrawal</i> before the first day of the term or semester. <i>75% Withdrawal</i> if not more than 1/8 of the term or semester has elapsed. <i>25% Withdrawal</i> if not more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed. <i>0% Withdrawal</i> if more than 1/4 of the term or semester has elapsed. *Refund schedule is calculated based on the first calendar day of the term and includes all weekdays, Monday through Friday, which are not designated official Central Texas College holidays.
PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION	
Tuition Assistance: Active Duty military students approved under this program will have 100% of the tuition and fees paid by the government.
