

## CLEP Examinations with CTC Credit Recommendations

CLEP is sponsored by the College Board. It is a nationally recognized credit-by-examination program, helping students of all ages to earn credit for what they already know. Credit is awarded based on the ACE recommended credit score and institutional guidelines. The scores below are for the computer-based exams. If there is a discrepancy in the scores listed below and the ACE recommended credit score on the official CLEP transcript, credit will be awarded based on the ACE recommended credit score. The evaluation request and official CLEP transcript must be received within seven years of the testing date. If a CLEP test is not listed, CTC does not award credit. Before taking a CLEP exam for CTC credit, contact the CTC Evaluations Office for the most recent policies on the award of credit for CLEP exams.

Note 1: Effective July 1, 2007, Principles of Accounting is no longer available; however, credit **may** be awarded for tests taken prior July 1, 2007, (if within the 7 year timeframe).

Note 2: Essay required. Credit will not be awarded for tests taken without the essay.

Note 3: Students are encouraged to take College Composition with Essay, but College Composition Modular with Essay will be accepted. Credit will not be awarded for tests taken without essay.

Note 4: Credit **may** be awarded only after successful completion of ENGL 1301 and ENGL 1302.

Note 5: Effective April 17, 2008, a new CLEP French exam was released. The minimum score for the new Level 2 exam is 59.

Note 6: Student may take the CLEP for either HIST 1301 **or** HIST 1302 but not both since neither tests for Texas History, a legislative mandate.

Note 7: Effective July 1, 2006, Trigonometry and College Algebra-Trigonometry are no longer available; however, credit **may** be awarded for tests taken prior to July 1, 2006, (if within the 7 year timeframe).

Note 8: Awarded only if student has met the MATH 2412 prerequisite as listed in the CTC Catalog.
