Payment Info

The tuition listed includes the General Fee and lab fee charges but does NOT include and fees for individualized instruction or other fees that are charged for special programs.

Tuition and fees are due and payable at the time of registration.

Cash, Check, Money Order, Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover are accepted.

Please Note: Students will be charged the non-resident tuition rate for any course in which the student has previously enrolled, or a course of substantially the same content and level as the one enrolled, two or more times. Payment is required at the time of registration. Your registration is not finalized until payment is received. You cannot participate in class if registration is not finalized. It is your responsibility to make sure that your registration is finalized. You can verify this by looking up your account on the web.

Students are responsible for any additional amounts due CTC from post-enrollment audits and corrections, including all fees and waivers; i.e. registration assessing errors, dropping or adding classes, invalid employment or third-parties' waivers, etc.

CTC will accept tuition assistance (sponsor) agreements in lieu of payment at time of registration, but students will be responsible for all amounts owed if sponsoring agency does not remit payment in full.

Students who register for classes during late registration will not be eligible to receive a 100% refund on the dropped classes.
