TIMELY WARNING NOTIFICATION BULLETIN #06-001
Possible Threat to the Campus Community
“Your Right to Know”
September 28, 2006

In compliance with the “Timely Notice” provisions of the federal **Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998** the Central Texas College Police Department are giving notice of a disturbing act of potential violence reported to possibly occur at Central Texas College, Central Campus.

REPORTED OFFENSE: Terroristic Threat, constituting a written or verbal threat to commit any offense involving violence to any person or property with intent to cause a reaction of any type to this threat by an official or volunteer agency organized to deal with emergencies; place any person in fear of imminent serious bodily injury; prevent or interrupt the occupation or use of a building; room; place of assembly; place to which the public has access; place of employment or occupation; aircraft, automobile, or other form of conveyance; or other public place. This threat occurred against the CTC Central Campus location and it’s employees.

SUSPECT: Mai Aliesa Dartez, Asian female, DOB: 05/05/64, Black hair, brown eyes, height 5’1”, 105 lbs. Mai is a former CTC employee currently living in Oklahoma.

It has continually been reported that Dartez makes written and verbal threats to current CTC employees. Most recently Dartez threatened to “blow up the CTC Campus with a bomb”. Dartez is capable of violence and has been arrested twice in the past on similar charges by the CTC Campus Police Department. Dartez should be considered dangerous and any contact by/with her should be reported to the Campus Police immediately.

DETERMINATION: Possibility of incident occurring is potential however, neither currently probable nor imminent as suspect resides out of state.

INVESTIGATIVE AUTHORITY: CTC Police Department; FBI Waco Regional Office; Homeland Security.

SERVICE: An arrest warrant has been issued by Judge Garland Potvin, Bell County Justice of the Peace, Precinct 4-1, for Terrorist Threat, Class A Misdemeanor.

It can be assumed that conditions continue to exist that may pose a threat to members and guests of the campus community. It is the duty of the institution and the Campus Police to warn of possible “dangerous conditions” on or near its campus, and at affiliate organizations off campus; an “affirmative duty” exists to warn persons associated with this college of possible peril at the hands of some third party or parties.

Please make this warning available to your colleagues and post it on appropriate bulletin boards in your area.
