

## IMMUNIZATION AVAILABILITY

### **STUDENTS WITH HEALTH INSURANCE:**

Most insurance companies will provide the vaccine with the normal immunization copay. Contact your health care provider or insurance company to determine coverage.

You may also be eligible to receive the vaccine from an area “community vaccinator pharmacy” like Walmart, HEB, Walgreens or CVS.

### **STUDENTS WITHOUT HEALTH INSURANCE:**

Students under 19 may be eligible under the Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) Program to receive the immunization at participating doctors’ offices or clinics. To be eligible for the TVFC Program, you must have Medicaid or CHIP or be an American Indian or Alaskan Native or be uninsured or underinsured.
