

TASL Workshop III Assessment Analysis

Of the 52 participants registered for this event, 30 attended (it was the day before hurricane Katrina), and 29 returned the Workshop Evaluation Instrument. According to the participants' reporting, there were 8 administrators, 4 QEP or SACS related, and 18 faculty representatives present. There was some overlapping of duties indicated. Disciplines or Programs represented included "Vocational Education, Mental Health Services, Nursing, Developmental Studies, Office Technology, Institutional Effectiveness, Business Affairs, Institutional Research, College Prep and Support Services, Social Sciences, Computer Science, Instructional Services, English as a Second Language, Political Science and History, and Student Services."

Participants rated the overall value of this workshop as Good (5%) or Excellent (95%). The format of the workshop was rated as Suitable (100%). One hundred per cent of the participants reported that they would use the information presented by the workshop speaker on their own campus. Suggestions for future TASL workshops were outcomes assessment, writing grants, discipline specific assessment strategies, QEP development, and student learning outcomes. "Other Feedback" is listed in the chart below.
