

Who can register online and who can't?

Attention! eArmyU/Active Duty Army using Tuition Assistance must register through the GoArmyEd Portal

Those who can register online:

1. Students who have attended Central Texas College classes in Texas within the last 12 months and do not have any holds on their records and their application and residency status are current.
2. Students who have attended Central Texas College distance learning classes within the last 12 months and do not have any holds on their records and their application and residency status are current.
3. New students who have completed the admissions process, academic advisement and testing for course placement purposes.
4. Former students who have completed the readmissions process and have no restrictions/holds on their records.

Those who cannot register online:

1. Students who have never taken a class at Central Texas College and have not applied for admission as the student residency status must be determined through the application process (in district, in state, or out of state).
2. Students who have not taken classes with in the last 12 months at Central Texas College. Student must submit a new application to update admission and reaffirm residency status.
3. Students registering for credit classes who have only taken noncredit classes at Central Texas College as all college credit admissions requirements must be met.
4. Active Duty Army students using military Tuition Assistance must register through the GoArmyEd portal.
5. Students who are registering for the same course for the third time. You must register in person.
6. Students in skill center classes must first visit with a Skill Center Counselor. You will receive assistance in setting up your class. At that time you will be provided with information on how to register. ([link](#))
7. Students who have any holds on their records. ([link](#))
8. For active duty military and their family members who are nonresidents, a military verification form signed by their commander or designated representative must be provided to the Admissions Office to be eligible for an in-state tuition waiver. Military identification card must also be presented. Upon receipt of the required documents, students are eligible to register if admission requirements have been met and there are no holds on the student record.
9. High school students who are enrolling for dual credit or early admissions. The Admissions Office must have the dual credit and early admissions form with the required signatures each semester.
