TIMELY WARNING NOTIFICATION BULLETIN #2014-001

Possible Threat to the Campus Community

“Your Right to Know”

DATE: JUNE 23, 2014

In compliance with the “Timely Notice” provisions of the federal **Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998** the Central Texas College Police Department are giving notice of a disturbing act of potential violence reported to possibly occur at Central Texas College, Central Campus.

DETERMINATION: THREAT MADE BY FORMER STUDENT TO DO BODILY HARM TO A CURRENT CTC INSTRUCTOR.

PROBABILITY OF INCIDENT REOCCURRING - MODERATE

REPORTED OFFENSE: TERRORISTIC THREAT – INVESTIGATION PENDING

SUSPECT: WHITE MALE, EARLY 20’S, SHORT BROWN HAIR, BEARD

INVESTIGATIVE AUTHORITY: CTCPD, BELL COUNTY ATTORNEY OFFICE

SERVICE: CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION PENDING

STUDENT ISSUED CAMPUS TRESPASS WARNING ON JUNE 20, 2014 AND WILL BE ARRESTED ON-SITE UPON HIS RETURN.

It can be assumed that conditions continue to exist that may pose a threat to members and guests of the campus community. It is the duty of the institution and the Campus Police to warn of possible “dangerous conditions” on or near its campus, and at affiliate organizations off campus; an “affirmative duty” exists to warn persons associated with this college of possible peril at the hands of some third party or parties.
