



## **TIMELY WARNING NOTIFICATION BULLETIN #2015-002**

**Possible Threat to the Campus Community**

**“Your Right to Know”**

**DATE: May 6, 2015**

In compliance with the “Timely Notice” provisions of the federal **Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998** the Central Texas College Police Department are giving notice of a disturbing act of potential violence reported to possibly occur at Central Texas College, Central Campus.

**DETERMINATION:** A FEMALE CTC STUDENT WAS APPROACHED BY TWO UNKNOWN WHITE MALES WHO STATED THEY WERE IN A “RADIO CONTEST” AND ASKED HER A SERIES OF QUESTIONS. AFTER ANSWERING THE QUESTIONS THE MEN STATED SHE WAS NOW REQUIRED TO PAY THEM \$100 OR THEY WOULD GET IN TROUBLE. THE FEMALE WITHDREW THE MONEY FROM THE ATM MACHINE IN THE ANDERSON CAMPUS CENTER AND GAVE IT TO THE MEN. THE MEN THEN QUICKLY LEFT IN AN SEPARATE UNKNOWN DIRECTIONS.

**PROBABILITY OF INCIDENT REOCCURRING:** HIGH

**REPORTED OFFENSE:** THEFT BY DECEPTION

**SUSPECT:** TWO UNKNOWN WHITE MALES; ONE BIG AND TALL WITH BLONDE HAIR AND GLASSES; ONE SHORTER STOCKY BUILD AND BALDING. NEITHER MALES ARE BELIEVED TO BE AFFILIATED WITH CTC.

**INVESTIGATIVE AUTHORITY:** CTC POLICE DEPARTMENT

**SERVICE:** IF APPROACHED WITH REQUEST TO PAY FOR ANY TYPE SERVICES IMMEDIATELY CONTACT CAMPUS POLICE.

It can be assumed that conditions continue to exist that may pose a threat to members and guests of the campus community. It is the duty of the institution and the Campus Police to warn of possible “dangerous conditions” on or near its campus, and at affiliate organizations off campus; an “affirmative duty” exists to warn persons associated with this college of possible peril at the hands of some third party or parties. Report suspicious activity immediately by dialing 777 from any on campus office phone OR 254-526-1427 from any phone.
