Why CTC

Who we are

For more than 50 years, Central Texas College (CTC) has been committed to the mission of providing students from the local area and around the world with quality education. CTC serves military personnel and their families stationed at military installations in Europe, Alaska, parts of the Middle East, Africa, Panama as well as throughout the continental United States. Central Texas College is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.

What we offer

The Europe Campus of Central Texas College is contracted to offer members of the military community Associate of Applied Science degrees and certificates in a variety of career and technical programs. The programs are geared to the military professional, taking into account occupations unique to military specialties.

Admissions

CTC is an open-enrollment public community college. There is no application fee.

A student who has graduated from an accredited high school or has a GED certificate, and is a valid U.S. uniformed services ID card holder, is eligible for admission. Adults, veterans and military personnel 18 years or older who have not completed high school may be admitted if the individual can demonstrate the ability to benefit from instruction.

Establishing credit

CTC evaluates and accepts many kinds of education experiences including military, civilian, traditional and nontraditional for credit toward an associate's degree.

College courses from degree granting institutions which are accredited by a regional accrediting association in which the student has earned a grade of "C" or better or "P" will be accepted as transfer credit.

Getting evaluated

Students can have previous credits and/or civilian/military work experience evaluated in order to create a student agreement and a degree plan with CTC. Get a free unofficial evaluation of your military credits at fastforward.ctcd.edu.

After selecting your preferred degrees, select CTC as your home college. When your application is processed and upon receipt of all official college transcripts and the Joint Service Transcript (JST), you will receive an official evaluation on the portal within 4-6 weeks. It will then be posted on GoArmyEd. The student is responsible for having all transcripts from previously attended colleges and universities and the JST (ex-AARTS) transcript submitted to the following address:

ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREES

Automotive Mechanic/Technician

Designed to meet the current needs of the rapidly changing automotive industry, this program provides hands-on experience using modern equipment.

Child Development

This program provides the needed skills and academic training required to meet the demands of positions including child care assistant, child care provider, and pre-school teacher.

Criminal Justice

The program's general course work helps provide students with the knowledge and skills needed to pursue a position in law enforcement, courts or corrections. Evaluative credit toward this degree may be awarded for equivalent military or civilian work experience.

Cybersecurity (Downrange only)

This program provides an introduction to data control and security.

Emergency Medical Technology

Upon completion of EMSP 1401 and 1160, students are eligible to take the National Registry of EMTs certification exam and may continue studies to be eligible to become certified as paramedics.

Fire Protection

CTC's fire protection degree program is offered to individuals seeking professional knowledge and skills in the pursuit of a career as a firefighter.

Homeland Security and Emergency Management

This program prepares students for decision-making, problem-solving and skills to plan, implement and coordinate resources necessary for preparedness, mitigation, response and recovery from disasters.

Hospitality Management

The program is designed for individuals seeking managerial positions in the food service or lodging fields.

HOW THE PROGRAMS WORK

Each degree plan described includes a total of 60 credit hours of coursework for associate degrees and 15-49 credits for certificates of completion. Students can view degree plans at: www.ctcd.edu/europe.

The classes specific to each program are taught online, on site in the classroom or in suitable facilities by faculty highly qualified in their area.
