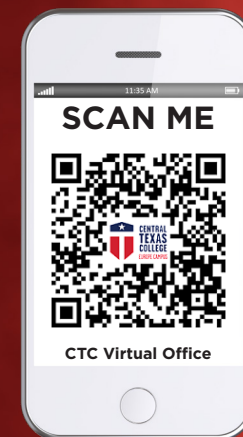

Who we are

For more than 50 years, Central Texas College (CTC) has been committed to the mission of providing students from the local area and around the world with quality education. CTC serves military personnel and their families stationed at military installations in Europe, Alaska, Hawaii as well as throughout the continental United States.

What we offer

The Europe Campus of Central Texas College is contracted to offer members of the military community Associate of Applied Science degrees and certificates in a variety of career and technical programs.

Admissions

CTC is an open-enrollment public community college. There is no application fee.

A student who has graduated from an accredited high school or has a GED certificate, and is a valid U.S. uniformed services ID card holder, is eligible for admission. Adults, veterans and military personnel 18 years or older who have not completed high school may be admitted if the individual can demonstrate the ability to benefit from instruction.

Establishing credit

CTC evaluates and accepts many kinds of education experiences including military, civilian, traditional and nontraditional for credit toward an associate's degree.

College courses from degree granting institutions which are accredited by a regional accrediting association in which the student has earned a grade of "C" or better or "P" will be accepted as transfer credit.

ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREES

Automotive Mechanic/Technician

Designed to meet the current needs of the rapidly changing automotive industry, this program provides hands-on experience using modern equipment.

Child Development

This program provides the needed skills and academic training required to meet the demands of positions including child care assistant, child care provider, and pre-school teacher.

Criminal Justice

The program's general course work helps provide students with the knowledge and skills needed to pursue a position in law enforcement, courts or corrections. Evaluative credit toward this degree may be awarded for equivalent military or civilian work experience.

Fire Protection

CTC's fire protection degree program is offered to individuals seeking professional knowledge and skills in the pursuit of a career as a firefighter.

Fire Service Administration

CTC's program prepares students for supervisory roles in Fire Protection. The degree provides key management competencies, including office management, accounting and human resources.

Homeland Security and Emergency Management

This program prepares students for decision-making, problem-solving and skills to plan, implement and coordinate resources necessary for preparedness, mitigation, response and recovery from disasters.

Hospitality Management

The program is designed for individuals seeking managerial positions in the food service or lodging fields.

Medical Coding & Billing

This program develops the skills necessary for converting health information and patient data into a universal, medical, alphanumeric code - an essential and emerging area of the healthcare field.

HOW THE PROGRAMS WORK

Each degree plan described includes a total of 60 credit hours of coursework for associate degrees and 15-49 credits for certificates of completion. Students can view degree plans at: www.ctcd.edu/europe.

The classes specific to each program are taught online, on site in the classroom or in suitable facilities by faculty highly qualified in their area.
