Program Crosswalk: AS in Business Administration to Bachelor of Sport & Recreation Business

The AS in Business Administration will qualify for a general education requirements waiver at the University of Alaska Fairbanks with the exception of SPRT 281: Introduction to Sport Management course, which is a degree-specific general education requirement.

- **Highlighted rows indicate requirements will be satisfied with completion of AS at CTC.

NOTE: Transfer students must complete at least 30 residence credits at UAF. 39 upper-division (300- and 400-level courses) must be completed to earn a bachelor's degree at UAF. 120 credits are needed to earn a bachelor's degree at UAF.

NOTE: Students must fulfill the Alaska Native Theme requirement (3 credits), which is not built into the major requirements. It is recommended that students fulfill the Alaska Native Theme requirement through their major elective requirement in ACCT, BA, ECON, HSEM, or SPRT by choosing either ECON F111X: Rural Economy of Alaska, BA F391: Alaska Native Corporations, or HSEM F461: Human Security in Alaska.

NOTE: This degree may require students to take additional electives as needed to get to 120 credit hours.
