Course Description:

BMGT-1091 – Introduction to Enterprise Systems

This course is an introduction to enterprise systems with a particular emphasis on SAP software. This includes the fundamentals of enterprise resource planning system concepts and the importance of how they are used within an organization.

ITSC-1091 – ERP Configuration

This is an advanced level course that will focus on the implementation phase of ERP systems. Emphasis is based on three key areas of defining and assigning user organizational levels defining master data requirements, and implementation of business rules for each module of an enterprise system.

ITSC-1092 – Enterprise Systems, Tools, Concepts, and Careers

This seminar course provides an overview discussion of ERP emerging trend and projects to include a look at the ERP software tools, reviewing case studies, and preview of career path generated by enterprise systems.

BMGT-1097 – ERP Business Process integration with Simulation

This course emphasizes the integration of enterprise systems within an organization using a sequence of live ERP simulation games.

BMGT-1095 – ERP Program CAPSTONE

The capstone course in ERP systems leads students through the official SAP TERP10 (training ERP in 10 days) certification course culminating in the SAP professional certification exam.

Refunds of Tuition and Fees

No tuition refunds will be made except in the case of cancellation or official withdrawal from Central Texas College or from a course. Refunds for tuition will be computed from the date the Application for Withdrawal is filed with the Records Office (not from the date of last attendance) or processed through the GoArmyEd portal for Army TA students. Students must submit a completed Application for Refund to the Business Office for a refund to be issued.
