

CTC CREDIT RECOMMENDATIONS ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS

Advanced Placement (AP) examinations provide a means to demonstrate college-level accomplishments. Although high school students often take the AP examination after completing an AP course at their high school, the AP examinations can be taken by home schooled students or other students whose high school does not offer AP courses.

CTC requires that students earn a score of 3, 4, or 5 on the AP examination and meet all other institutional requirements to be eligible to receive college credit. Official AP scores must be received within 10 years of the testing date. Official scores transcript must be sent directly from College Board to CTC
