

Application Process for the Nursing Programs

	Apply to CTC	Apply to Central Texas College (CTC) and complete the application process with CTC.
	Program Information Session	You will need to complete the online Nursing Program Information Session. You must complete at least one session 6 months before ranking. *see the Deadlines for Nursing Applicants on the CTC Nursing Website for exact deadlines
	Submit Transcripts	Submit official college and/or high school transcripts to CTC Incoming Transcripts Office.
	Academic Advisor	Meet with a CTC Academic Advisor . *Remember to have your official or unofficial college and/or high school transcripts with you.
	Be TSI Complete	Complete the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirements and request a TSI Status Verification Request via eForms. You will then receive an email saying your TSI Status Verification Form has been processed and is available for review, click on the link. The transcript is attached to your eForms in your Inbox. Click Submit to have the TSI Verification auto-filed into your electronic student file for department review. (Note: You will need to submit the form twice in this process.)
	Prerequisites (lab science courses & HPRS 2300 expire after 5 years)	Complete the prerequisite course work and earn a GPA of 2.8 or higher (overall and on lab science courses).* • Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) • Articulating (ART) • Vocational Nursing (VN): Prerequisites are BIOL 2401 & HPRS 2300 (Evening & Weekend VN Program) *program degree plan for prerequisite courses required can be found by clicking on the specific program in blue
	HESI A2	Successfully complete the HESI A2 examination. It must be taken no more than two years before rankings . We recommended taking the HESI A2 during your last prerequisite course.
	Immunizations	AFTER you are notified of selection to the ADN or VN Program and prior to registration for the first semester of nursing courses, you must provide documentation of mandatory immunizations.
	Apply to Program	When you are ready to apply for the next rankings period, complete and submit an application for the Nursing Program you want to apply for at:
	Rankings	Rankings are done in April for Fall Semester and September for Spring Semester.
	Admission	Letters of admission will be sent out via email to your CTC Eagle Mail no later than May 1st for Fall Semester and October 1st for Spring Semester.
	Orientation Invite Only	Program Orientation information will be sent via email to your CTC Eagle Mail with letters of admission. Program Orientations are held in May for Fall Semester and October for Spring Semester.
