

Student TSIA Remediation Using My Math Test

Central Texas College has created a My Math Test (MMT) program for any CTC student to use as a tool for TSIA prep/remediation.

Cost: \$12.00 to the student directly from Pearson.

Site: www.mymathtest.com

Create a course in MyMathTest by copying the master course ID provided by Central Texas College.

Students can then enroll in the copied course by using the course code created above.

The course contains two diagnostic tests: Beginning Algebra and Intermediate Algebra. They are separated into the two levels on the TSI Assessment. Each test has 50 problems; the students will have 120 minutes to complete each diagnostic.

It is best to complete both tests before starting the remediation practice, then you will have the whole picture of what is missing. Remediation can be done in the Study Plan. The results are already built based on what students get incorrect in the diagnostic test. Students can progress through the concepts by using the Practice Tool and the Quiz Me to prove Mastery. (We recommend using the Show All Chapters.) As mastery occurs the symbol will change to a graduation cap.

The course also contains two Final Exams: Beginning Algebra and Intermediate Algebra. Each test has 25 problems; the students have 120 minutes to complete each Final Exam.
