

HESI A2 Exam

The Evolve HESI A2 exam is a computerized test that can include up to 5-academic exam sections. The HESI A2 is a requirement for all paramedic students and must be taken **before** applying for admission into the Paramedic Program.

HESI A2 exams greater than 2 years old will not be accepted.

The CTC Department of Health Sciences Paramedicine Program requires all applicants to take the below listed sections; each section shows the recommended time allotment along with its minimum score requirement.

All graduates of Central Texas College's EMT-Basic program are EXEMPT from the HESI A2 exam.

- **Math:** 50 minutes **70% minimum score**
- **Reading Comprehension:** 60 minutes **70% minimum score**
- **Anatomy & Physiology:** 25 minutes **No minimum score**
- **Vocabulary/General Knowledge:** 50 minutes **70% minimum score**
- **Personality Profile / Learning Styles:** 15 minutes each section
- **Grammar:** 50 minutes **70% minimum score**

**CTC does not require the Biology, Physics, or Critical Thinking sections.*

Exam Days/Times:

- The HESI A2 is offered by appointment only. Appointments can be scheduled either by email: testing.clerk@ctcd.edu or calling 254-526-1520.
- **Students must sign in between 7:45 AM - 8:00 AM**
- Any student without an appointment will not be tested.

Exam Fee and Payment Information:

- The cost of the test is \$50.
- Payment can be made the day of the exam via **EXACT CASH ONLY** OR in advance via credit card/ cash/check at the Business Office (Building 209).
- You will need to bring two copies of your receipt for proof of payment on the day of the exam.
- **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**

Things to Bring on Exam Day:

- **Photo ID** (such as Driver's License, Passport, or Student ID).
- **Evolve Username and Password** (created before test day).

Things NOT to Bring:

- Calculator – not permitted.
- Textbooks, Study Guides, any form of reference material.
- Scratch paper or pencils – Testing Services will provide.
- No personal items for test security. Limit what you bring to the Testing Center.
- The Testing Center is not responsible for any personal items.

Score Reports

- Students will be able to view their scores at the time the test is complete.
- The Department of Health Sciences will have access to score reports for exams taken at CTC.
- Should you need a copy of your scores, you can access your report online using your login credentials on the HESI A2 website.

Exam Retake

- You may take the exam as many times as you like. If you fail twice, it is recommended that you remediate for 5 months before retaking the exam but not required.

FAQ'S

How can I prepare?

Remember to bring your username and password with you on your test date to log into the HESI A2 exam. You **MUST** set-up your Evolve account **before** arriving on test day. To do this visit, www.evolve.elsevier.com

Review related class notes, study guides and/or entrance exam review books. Elsevier publishes a HESI review book specifically for this exam. If you have taken the exam previously, you can review content related to missed items through the website: www.evolve.elsevier.com

Is the exam timed?

You are given a maximum time of 3 hours and 30 minutes to complete all required sections. Each section of the test is **individually timed**. If individual sections are completed before the allotted time of that section, the remaining time does not accrue towards the remainder of the test. If the maximum time is used for each section, it may take up to the maximum time given to finish the entire HESI A2 exam.

Can I use a calculator for the math exam?

There is a calculator given during the exam that may be used. It will be on the right-hand side of the screen and will say "Show Calculator". No scientific or programmable calculators are allowed.

What if I need the department ID?

Remember:

- ✓ The HESI A2 exam **must** be completed with passing scores prior to registration into the Paramedic Program.
- ✓ No HESI A2 exams **greater than 2 years old** will be accepted.
