In-Text Citations: Use the author's last name and publication date. Page numbers are provided for direct quoted materials.

Paraphrase and Summary Format :
(Author Year) / (Editor Year)

(Pearce 2010).

In his book, *Pitt the Elder*, Pearce (2010) ...

Direct Quotes Format:

(Author's last name, Year, Page number).

... "Whatever orders..." (Pearce 2010, 138).

... Pearce (2010, 138) noted that "Whatever orders..."

OR

... Pearce noted that "Whatever orders..." (2010, 138).

Two-Three Authors:

(1st Author and 2nd Author Year)

(Lee and Tirnady 2003).

Lee and Tirnady (2003) ...

More than Three Authors:

(1st Author, et al. Year)

(Versalovic et al. 2011).

Versalovic et al. (2011)...

No Author:

(Use a short form of the title Year)

(*Fundamentals of Nursing* 2013).

Fundamentals of Nursing (2013)...

GENERAL FORMAT GUIDELINES:

COVER PAGE ELEMENTS:

Title of the Paper—is 1/3 down from the top of the page. It is in all capital letters.

Subtitle— If present, place a colon after the title. The subtitle is on the next line below the title.

Author Information— Centered, single spaced and 1/3 up from the bottom of the page.

1st line—author's name

2nd line—course number and name

3rd line—Date in Month Day, Year format

Font— Times New Roman or Palatino, size 12 preferred.

Body of the Paper— Double spaced, except for block quotes, table titles, and figure captions. The title of the paper is not repeated at the top of the page. Pagination begins with this page.

References— The word References is centered at the top of its own page. It is not underlined, bolded or in all capital letters.

Source citations—are listed alphabetically, in a hanging indented format, and single spaced with a line between each listed item.

REFERENCES LIST:

REFERENCES— The word References is centered at the top of its own page. It is not underlined, bolded or in all capital letters.

SOURCE CITATIONS—Are listed alphabetically, in a hanging indented format, and single spaced with a line between each listed item.

NO DATE— When there is not a publication date, use n.d. after the author's name.

ONE AUTHOR/EDITOR:

Author's Last Name, First Name. Year. *Title of Book*. Place of Publication: Publisher.
Pearce, Edward. 2010. *Pitt the Elder: Man of War*. London: Bodley Head.

TWO OR MORE AUTHORS:

1st author's name is inverted. Multiple authors names are given as first name last name. Order of names listed is by the subsequent authors' last names.

Burkholder, J. Peter, Donald Jay Grout, and Claude V Palisca. 2014. *A History of Western Music*. Ninth. New York: W.W. Norton & Company.

NO AUTHOR:

Title. Year. Place of Publication: Publisher.
The Middle East and North Africa. 1948. London: Europa Publications.

JOURNAL ARTICLES:

PRINT:

Author's Last Name, First Name. Year.

Use the organization's acronym, or abbreviation, if it has one, (the spelled out organization's name). Year. *Document Title*. Document ID Number. Place of Publication: Agency Abbreviation.

OSHA. (Occupational Safety and Health Administration). 2015. *OSHA Construction Regulations*. 29 CFR 1926. Davenport, IA: Mancomm.

VIDEO AND FILM RECORDINGS:

Author's Last Name, Author's First Name. Year. *Title of Film*. Name of Publisher, Format of Film. From Source, *Collection Name*. Medium, Duration of film. URL.
