The library's databases are changing. Due to a change in the State's **TexShare database contract**, access to the EBSCO databases will end on August 31, 2023. In the Fall 2022, we added a number of Gale Cengage databases. Gale is very similar to EBSCO; patrons will still have access to quality eBooks, full-text articles, and streaming videos. through February. All submissions are due March 10, 2023.


