IN-TEXT CITATIONS:

Used to denote referenced materials listed in the Works Cited: quoted, paraphrased, summarized, or statistics.

Parenthetical—(Author's Last Name Page #).

Narrative — Author's name is in the body of the sentence. The page number in parentheses is at the end of the sentence. NEW: For narrative in-text citations, the first time provide the author's first and last names. Afterwards, use only the author's last name.

One Author:

(Author's Last Name Page Number).

Parenthetical: (Weintraub 233).*1st Narrative:* According to David

Weintraub, ... (233).

2nd Narrative: Weintraub ...(321).

Two Authors:

(1st Author's Last Name and 2nd Author's Last Name Page Number).

Parenthetical: (Impey and Henry 88)1st Narrative: Chris Impey and Holly

Henry ... (88).

2nd Narrative: Impey and Henry ... (88).

Three or More Authors:

(1st Author's Last Name et al. Page Number).

Parenthetical: (Hobbes et al. 398).

1st Narrative: Thomas Hobbes and others ... (398).

2nd Narrative: Hobbes et al. ... (398).

Unknown Author:

Parenthetical—Provide the 1st one to three words of the title: (Scientific 58).

Narrative—Provide the primary title: Scientific Papers... (58).



WORKS CITED

The words Works Cited are centered at the top of the page; they are not bolded, underlined, enclosed in quote marks, or italicized. Items are double spaced, and in a hanging paragraph indented format. The indention is 1/2 inch from the paragraph. When there is not an author, use the source's title. NEW: The accessed date, is not required, but it is recommended when there is not a publication or copyright date available.

Three or More Authors: List only the first author's name, followed by et al.

Last Name, First Name MI, et al. *Title of the Book*. Publisher, Year.

Hobbes, Thomas, et al. Three Discourses: A Critical Modern Edition of Newly Identified Work of the Young Hobbes. University of Chicago Press, 1995.

Unknown Author:

Title of the Book. Publisher, Year.

Scientific Papers: Physics, Chemistry, Astronomy, Geology: With Introductions and Notes. P.F. Collier, 1910.

Corporate Author's Name. *Title of Book*. Publisher, Year.
