- To get a full listing of classes being offered, navigate to [online.ctcd.edu](http://online.ctcd.edu), from the **Quick Links drop menu**, choose **Online Schedule**. This provides a listing of the courses being offered for the term date you chose on the date drop list; the **TD sections** are online.
- To search for a specific class, you will need to know its alphanumeric. For example, Environmental Science alphanumeric is ENVR 1401. Navigate to [ctcd.edu](http://ctcd.edu), from **Student Tools** drop box, click **Search for Courses and Course Sections**. Put the alphanumeric in the search box in the upper right-hand corner and press Enter. Refine your search parameters under **Locations**, by checking the **Distance Learning box**. Once the course comes up, click the **"View Available Sections for"** box and a listing of the seats available and dates are provided.

**Course Descriptions:** Go to the College Catalog at [ctcd.edu](http://ctcd.edu), and on the **Academics drop menu**, under **Catalogs** chose **Continental & International**. Scroll down to **Course Descriptions** link to see an alphabetical listing of all the courses along with their descriptions and any prerequisites.
